
Instructional Manual

From the Start menu, open the **Control Panel**.

Click **Network and Sharing Center**.

Click **Connect to a network**.

Windows XP Users Microsoft Windows xp

When your laptop comes in range of a wireless signal, you'll see a balloon in the system tray (near the clock) saying "Wireless networks detected".

Click the balloon.

In the Wireless Network Connection window that opens, Click **HUHealthcare**

Open a web browser. You should be directed to the "Wireless Access Agreement"

Windows Vista Users Windows 7

From the Start menu, open the **Control Panel**.

Click **Network and Sharing Center**.

Click **Connect to a network**.
